Entries received after the postmark of October 20, 2009 will be charged an extra fee of \$10.00 per horse in addition to the regular class fees.

\$120.00 Flat Fee for Youth/Horse Combo

\$120.00 Flat Fee for Amateur/Horse Combo

Entries MUST be received by deadline for Flat Fee combos.

After the deadline, classes will be the normal listed fees.

Prepay for 10 stalls by the deadline and get your tack stall FREE! Stalls MUST be paid for in advance to receive your free stall.

8 am on Sunday

Youth Classes - \$20.00

Open and Amateur Classes - \$30.00

All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years old and older must have a stallion certificate in order to participate. All horses must be measured. Stalls are \$55.00 (Thursday - Sunday close of show - two horse maximum). All horses must be stabled. Camper hook-up, \$25.00 per night. Valid AMHA registration, current coggins within 12 months of show date, health certificate (within 30 days) for out of state horses. **Make checks payable to Miniature Horse Sales and mail check and entries to: Dixi A. General Rules and Information

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2009 rules of the American Miniature Horse Association. All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Association. This is a Three judge show.

Each judge will award point and certificate award.

Judges Evaluation Reports will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis.

Any exhibitor with Special Needs is welcome to participate in all shows.

General Rules and Information

- ENTRY FEES:** Open & Amateur Classes - \$30.00
Youth Classes and Special Needs- \$20.00
EARLY BIRD OCTOBER SHOW SPECIAL!! Entries MUST be postmarked by 10/20/09 to participate in the flat fee combinations.
\$120.00 flat fee for youth/horse combination - no youth/open class limit.
\$120.00 flat fee for amateur/horse combination - no amateur/open class limit.
NO ADDED CLASS ENTRIES FOR THE CURRENT DAY OF SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8:00AM ON THE MORNING OF THAT PARTICULAR SHOW DAY. If you need to add classes, add them the night before or before 8:00am!!
- STALLS:** \$55.00 (Thursday-Sunday close of Show) - maximum 2 horses per stall). Stall fee is the same for tack stalls. Stall cleanings are to be dumped in designated areas ONLY. All horses must be stalled. No showing out of trailers. Purchase and prepay for 10 stalls by the deadline of 10/20/09 and receive a tack stall **FREE!!!** Stalls must be prepaid in advance, by the deadline, to receive your free stall.
- MEASURING:** Measuring will take place on Thursday from 3pm - 6pm., Friday, Saturday 8am-9am. Measuring will be done as needed after those times. All horses must be measured. AMHA has suspended all measurement cards for 2009. Please have your registration papers available for identification. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurements.
- AWARDS:** All classes get certificates through 6th place. Certificates can be spent at concessions, tack vendors, or off the total bill at the office. Ribbons will be available to those interested in exchanging the certificates for ribbons. All certificates awarded expire on 11/01/09. Only October 2009 JFM Show certificates will be accepted.
- VENDORS:** \$90.00 per weekend with electrical hook-up.
- REFUNDS:** Refunds will not be given without a veterinarian's written certificate stating why the horse is unable to show. This is to be presented to the Show Manager at the show or within 7 days of the conclusion of the show. There will be NO REFUNDS on stall fees. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.
- ENTRIES DUE:** Entry deadline is October 20, 2009. All entry forms, copies of BOTH sides of AMHA registration papers of each horse, lease agreements, copy of youth and/or Amateur cards, and a check/money order for payment of classes, stalls, AMHA fees, etc. are to be sent to the Show Manager, Dixi A. Cohea. Checks are to be made payable to Miniature Horse Sales. **Any check not honored by bank will charged an additional \$20.00 and will be referred to parent organization for disciplinary action.**
- CONDUCT:** Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of that show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The Show Manager shall notify AMHA of any such disqualification when show results are reported.
Show Management reserves the right to expel any exhibitor or attendee for violating the rules of the facility and or show. As per AMHA Rule 132, all Association representatives shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation, and respect, and no person shall direct abusive or threatening conduct toward them. Anyone violating this rule may face further disciplinary action from the AMHA.

- P.A. SYSTEM:** It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to barn area are a management courtesy. **There will be a 2 minute gate call for all classes. If no tack hold has been requested, the gate will close and the class will be judged. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
