All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years old and older must have a stallion certificate in order to participate. All horses must be measured or present a valid permanent measurement card. Stalls are \$45.00 (Thursday - Sunday close of show - two horse maximum). All horses must be stabled. Camper hook-up, \$30.00 per night and available through the Celebration Grounds. Valid AMHA registration, current coggins within 12 months of show date, health certificate (within 30 days) for out of state horses. **Make checks payable to Tennessee Miniature Horse Volunteers (TMHV) and mail check and entries to: Dixi A. General Rules and Information

This show is sponsored by the Tennessee Miniature Horse Volunteers and accredited and conducted under the 2010 rules of the American Miniature Horse Association. All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Association. This show is a triple judge.

Each judge will award point and ribbons.

Judges Evaluation Reports will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis.

Any exhibitor with Special Needs is welcome to participate in all shows.

General Rules and Information

- ENTRY FEES:** Open & Amateur Classes - \$30.00
Youth Classes and Special Needs- \$15.00
NO ADDED CLASS ENTRIES FOR THE CURRENT DAY OF SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8:00AM ON THE MORNING OF THAT PARTICULAR SHOW DAY. If you need to add classes, add them the night before or before 8:00am!!
- STALLS:** \$45.00 (Thursday-Sunday close of Show) - maximum 2 horses per stall) First bag of shavings per stall is provided free. Any additional shavings will be available on the show grounds for a fee. Stall fee is the same for tack stalls. Stall cleanings are to be dumped in designated areas ONLY. All horses must be stalled.
- MEASURING:** Measuring will take place on Thursday from 3pm - 6pm., Friday, Saturday, and Sunday from 7:30 am-8am. Measuring will be done as needed after those times. All horses must be measured or present a measurement card. Please have your registration papers available for identification. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurements.
- AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in each class. Ribbons or Sashes will be awarded to Supreme Halter Horses.
- VENDORS:** \$65.00 per weekend with electrical hook-up.
- REFUNDS:** Refunds will not be given without a veterinarian's written certificate stating why the horse is unable to show. This is to be presented to the Show Manager at the show or within 7 days of the conclusion of the show. There will be NO REFUNDS on stall fees. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.
- ENTRIES DUE:** Entry deadline is April 10th, 2010. All entry forms, copies of BOTH sides of AMHA registration papers of each horse, lease agreements, copy of coggins papers, copy of youth and/or Amateur cards, and a check/money order for payment of classes, stalls, AMHA fees, etc. are to be sent to the Show Manager, Dixi A. Cohea. Checks are to be made payable to TMHV. Any check not honored by bank will be charged a \$20.00 fee and referred to parent organization for disciplinary action.
- CONDUCT:** Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of that show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The Show Manager shall notify AMHA of any such disqualification when show results are reported.
Show Management reserves the right to expel any exhibitor or attendee for violating the rules of the facility and or show. As per AMHA Rule 132, all Association representatives shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation, and respect, and no person shall direct abusive or threatening conduct toward them. Anyone violating this rule may face further disciplinary action from the AMHA.
